Re: Uniform 2018

Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

Many thanks for your continued support of the school and its policies. As well as enjoying a break with your child/children, parents and carers will no doubt, be organising a visit to the shops in order to replace or source any items of school uniform including footwear. Before you embark on this, please could I take this opportunity to remind you of our school uniform policy which I have outlined below. Our intention is to avoid any unnecessary confrontations with your child not being dressed in accordance with uniform policy on our return in September.

KS3 Boys:

- School blazer worn at all times
- White collared, short or long sleeved school shirt
- Prescribed navy and silver clip-on school tie
- Black school trousers - preferred style from **Children's Choice, Belper or Uniformity, Derby. No jeans, no skinny cut, no low fitting styles allowed**
- Navy blue V-necked jumper (optional for winter months - no logos or trademarks permitted).
- Plain grey or black socks
- **Black school shoes (no trainers/plimsolls or canvas), flat with black soles and laces. The shoe must be completely black**

KS4 Boys: As above with the following option of a "full" adult tie. The tie must be worn correctly at all times.

KS3 Girls:

- School blazer worn at all times
- White collared, short or long sleeved shirt
- Prescribed navy and silver clip-on school tie
- EITHER black full length school trousers (our preferred style). **No jeans, no skinny cut, no tight fit, no capri style, no culottes, no low fitting styles allowed or**
- A black skirt this must finish no higher than 5cm above the knee (our preferred style). No tight or pencil style skirts



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- Navy blue V-necked jumper (optional for winter months-no logos or trademarks permitted).
- Plain grey or black socks with trousers
- Black opaque tights or black/grey knee high socks with the skirt option

Black school shoes, flat with black soles and laces (no trainers/plimsolls or canvas). The shoe must be completely black.

KS4 Girls as above with the following option

Plain white short sleeved blouse with open neck. Girls may wear a regulation open neck blouse without a tie – there is only one style available from our uniform suppliers. Ties may only be worn with the collared shirt and collared shirts must not be worn without a tie. Please could you ensure that all items of school clothing, especially ties are named.

Please also note we would prefer coats and bags to be in colours that are in line with the silver, grey, navy and black theme of our uniform, however, this is not a compulsory element.

Jewellery of any description is not encouraged and is not practical for many reasons. One pair of small, plain stud or sleeper size earrings in each ear lobe and a watch are the only items allowed. Please note any items of jewellery must be removed before taking part in any PE activities. Nose studs, large dangly or hooped earrings, stretchers or any other types of piercing are not allowed and students will be asked to remove them.

Make up of any description is discouraged. Students will be required to remove any excessive make up. Nail varnish and false nails or extreme hairstyles or colours are not allowed.

In order to assist with this process, I will be checking the uniform of every student before we finish for our Summer term on Friday 20 July. Any student with items of clothing/shoes that are not in line with our uniform policy will be issued with a slip from Student Support Services. On the slip, the area of concern will be highlighted in order for this to be rectified before our return on Tuesday 4 September.

We are very proud of our school and our students and believe that high standards of uniform, behaviour, with all students being properly equipped and attending regularly gives each and every one of our students the very best chance of learning well and achieving their very best.

Thank you all very much in advance of your anticipated support and understanding. I wish you an enjoyable summer break.
