# **Exam preparation reminder**

A reminder that study leave will officially commence for Year 11 on Monday 17 June.

If, in discussion with your son/daughter, you decide that studying at home **after May half term** is the better option for your child, we are willing to make special consideration for exceptional cases only for students to begin their study leave from **Monday 3 June**. Applications for study leave should be submitted by Monday 20 May.

Parents will be contacted with an outcome of these applications in the coming weeks. Students who have been granted early study leave will be issued with a pass before half term so that they are able to leave site following exams. Any student without a pass will not be able to leave the site.
