

Support and Training programme for D of E Bronze Award at John Flamsteed School, 2024/2025

The Award is made up of four sections – volunteering, physical, skill and expedition. It is essential that the first three sections are completed before the final expedition takes place.

The expedition section includes the training and practice expedition as well as the final expedition, and it is therefore **also** essential that training sessions are attended and that participants take an active role in the learning involved.
