Dear Parent/Carer

I hope this letter finds you well and thank you for your continued support of our school.

I contacted all parents/carers a few weeks ago regarding punctuality to lessons and this is something I am focused on improving with our students in all years once the new term begins on Monday 6th January 2025.

Regular attendance and timely arrival to lessons are essential for your child's academic progress and overall well-being at school, and these are areas which post-16 providers and prospective employers always ask us to comment on during the application process when we are requested write a reference for any student.

To improve punctuality to lessons, the school timetable was changed to add 5-minutes movement time after Registration, in-between Period 1 & 2, and again between Period 4 & 5. I understand that occasional delays can happen, but repeated lateness can disrupt not only your child's learning but also the learning environment of other students. When a student arrives late to their lessons, they miss valuable learning time, which can affect their understanding of the subject matter and their ability to keep up with the rest of the class. Furthermore, this could result in gaps in their learning which may disadvantage them in their final examinations.

I kindly ask for your support in addressing this matter by encouraging your child to arrive to each lesson on time. If there are any circumstances contributing to their lateness to lessons, I would appreciate it if you could let school know so that we can work together to find a solution.

To address this area, and to make it clear to all students and their parents/carers, from 6th January 2025, the following action will be taken:

- 3 late to lessons in a half term = 30 minutes detention
- 6 late to lessons in a half term = 30 minutes detention
- 9 late to lessons in a half term = 1 hour detention.

Should this happen, Heads of Year will contact parents/carers of the student concerned and invite them into school to discuss their punctuality to lessons, with their child present. Every three instances of late to lesson after this time will result in a 1-hour detention.
