## EDUCATION RECORDS RESULTS SERVICE

There is a new way of collecting examination results which enables students to view their examination results electronically on their mobile phones, transfer their results to post-16 providers and store their results as a record for the future.

### What are Education Records?

Education records are part of a new service from the Department for Education (DfE) to provide students with their education information and help them share these details as part of their post-16 journey.

Education records contain unique education information for each student, including:

- their name, address and date of birth
- the schools they have attended
- their qualifications (after results are released)
- any support needs

### What do students need to do?

Education records will be issued on the DfE education record app. If students wish to make use of this new service, then they must download the app onto their phones from the Apple or Google App Stores. The rest of the issuing process will take place in school.

*Please note: the Apple version of the app requires iOS version 15.0 or newer and the Android version requires 8.1 or newer.*
