GCSE & BTEC RESULTS DAY – THURSDAY 20 AUGUST 2026

You are invited to collect your GCSE results from school on **Thursday 20 August between 8.30am and 11am**. You will need to enter the site via the main entrance and collect results from the **Dining Hall**.

You are required to sign for your results and confirm your Post-16 destination once you have received your results and before you leave site. Members of the senior leadership team will be available should you need to discuss your Post-16 pathway.

EDUCATION RECORDS RESULTS SERVICE

There is a new way of collecting examination results which enables students to view their examination results electronically on their mobile phones, transfer their results to post-16 providers and store their results as a record for the future.

What are Education Records?

Education records are part of a new service from the Department for Education (DfE) to provide students with their education information and help them share these details as part of their post-16 journey.

Education records contain unique education information for each student, including:

- their name, address and date of birth
- the schools they have attended
- their qualifications (after results are released)
- any support needs

What do students need to do?

Education records will be issued on the DfE education record app from **11am on Results Day**. If students wish to make use of this new service, then they must download the app onto their phones from the Apple or Google App Stores. The rest of the issuing process will take place in school.

Please note: the Apple version of the app requires iOS version 15.0 or newer and the Android version requires 8.1 or newer.

Once the app is downloaded then students will need to meet with Mrs Doohan to complete the process. Mrs Doohan will be available on Results Day in the Dining Hall to help complete the process for you.
